Dear Parents,

The Parents in our school have been faithful in making regular voluntary contributions to support the school in the costs of maintaining and developing the school site and buildings for the children's safety and learning.

As standard practice in Church schools, for many years this cost has been met by parental contributions. Indeed many non-church schools are now asking for contributions from parents. There are no funds available from the Local Authority to help the school budget meet these demands.

In the last 12 months St Faith's has upgraded the school facilities:

- We have installed a separate room in the play area at the end of the atrium to allow for more 1 to 1 and small group interventions and possible instrumental lessons,
- Redeveloped the school kitchen to cater for the increased demand for school meals,
- Updated and decorated the school front offices,
- Rebuilt the front entrance and atrium to increase security and develop more learning spaces for group work.

During this next year we have plans that will shortly be available for parents to view, to develop the school atrium. The Student Council have asked to take the lead to redevelop the back playground.

We are therefore asking for a minimum contribution of **£30.00 per child per year**. Please send your contribution to the front office in an envelope marked *School Development Fund*. If you wish to pay by cheque then please make cheques payable to St Faith's CE School. Contributions of £10.00 can be made termly if this is more suitable.
